- A willingness to change behaviour in a positive direction
- Awareness of the importance of using common management-related terminology

The MRM course covers the following topics:

1. Attitudes and Management Skills
2. Cultural Awareness
3. Communication and Briefings
4. Challenge and Response
5. Short Term Strategy
6. Authority and Assertiveness
7. Management Styles
8. Workload
9. State of the Ship
10. Human Involvement in Error
11. Judgment and Decision Making
12. Leadership in Emergencies
13. Crisis and Crowd Management
14. Automation Awareness

Course intake limitation
